How much time can I take off?

- We offer one month paid leave when you've been with us for more than 3.5 years.
- You'll be paid 50% of your salary.
- You can also manually add five days holiday on top of your booked off sabbatical.
- You can only take a sabbatical once every 3.5 years.

Will my sabbatical include bank or public holidays?

- Yes. Your sabbatical is always one month long. If any bank or public holidays fall during your sabbatical, they will not be added on as extra days.

What should I do if I'm planning to take a sabbatical?

- If you'd like to request sabbatical leave, we ask that you give your line manager at least six months' notice.
- You should also let the rest of the company know with three months' notice.

Why did we decide to offer 50% salary pay?

Many companies offer longer but unpaid sabbaticals. We decided to offer 50% pay to make sure everyone, including junior team members, felt comfortable taking this time. This way, we can strike a balance between people's needs and what is commercially viable for the business.

How do I book it off?

- Once it's been approved by your line manager, you can book sabbatical leave on Charlie.
- Holiday is not accrued so we will manually deduct two days from your holiday allowance.

When can't I book my sabbatical?

- To make sure we keep momentum in the company, we will limit the number of people on sabbatical leave to one at a time.
